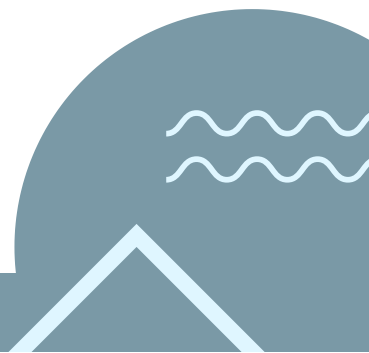

Graduate Dormitory	NT\$12,700 (Internet fee NT\$300 not included)	NT\$2,000	A room with a private bathroom shared between two residents.
Undergraduate Dormitory	Non-air conditioner room NT\$8,500 Air conditioner room NT\$9,900 (Internet fee NT\$300 not included)	NT\$2,000	A room shared between four residents.

Note that the dormitories are managed by NCNU's Student Housing Service Division, Office of Student Affairs. You cannot choose the room type; a room will be directly assigned to you. The amount of rooms isn't unlimited, therefore we cannot guarantee that you will be granted your most preferred choice. Note that we currently do not provide student accommodation for couples and families.

Textbook costs	Average about NT\$2,000 to NT\$3,000 each semester.
Accommodation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Undergraduate Dormitory (room for 4): NT\$8,500 (non air conditioner room) or NT\$9,900 (with air conditioner) for each person/semester; the Internet facilities fee NT\$300/semester.• Graduate Dormitory (room for 2): NT\$12,700 (with air conditioner) for each person/semester; the Internet facilities fee NT\$300/semester.• Cash deposit of NT\$2,000 is required, and refunded at the time of check out.
Living expenses	Approximately NT\$6,000 per month.
Health Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foreign Student Medical Insurance: NT\$4,956 (\$826*6 months) per semester.• Life Insurance: NT\$290 per semester.
Other fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Language equipment charge NT\$750/semester. (elective course for English Listening Comprehension)• Sports facilities fee NT\$550/semester.• Computer and network communication fee NT\$350/semester.
